- One-off grants are now available for Sheffield-based arts, cultural and heritage organisations through Sheffield Culture Showcase's Creative Communities Fund.
- The grants aim to support the delivery of creative programmes of outreach, engagement and participation in the city.
- Successful projects will take place between March 2024 and March 2025.

Site Gallery is working with Sheffield City Council to manage the Sheffield Creative Communities Fund. They invite eligible organisations to submit proposals for arts-led activity which is designed to benefit communities in areas of Sheffield with low levels of arts engagement and for people from lower socio-economic backgrounds.
